Installation Instructions:

- 1. Disconnect the negative battery cables.
- 2. Loosen the clamp the clamp holding the air duct to the turbo mainfold.
- 3. Remove the two screws holding the MAF sensor into the air duct
- 4. Pull up on the air box and remove the factory system from the engine compartment
- 5. Remove the factory mounting tray
- 6. Remove the plastic plate behind the headlight by pulling stright back to dislodge the 2 tree rivets
- 7. Place the 32" trim sponge around the volant air box hole where it meets the fender
- 8. Hand tighten the right rear truss head screw in the back of the volant box making sure the slot in the lid will still slide in
- 9. Place the volant box into factory position and tighten down with the 6mm hardware provided
- 10. Attach the 4.5 hump hose to the turbo mainfold using a #72 clamp
- 11. Slide the volant duct into the hump hose and into the volant box, bolt the duct to the air box than tighten the remaining #72 clamp
- 12. With the filter clamp removed lip the bottom of the filter flange around the air duct and press the filter onto the duct, then fish the clamp around, tighten the filter clamp
- 13. Attach the volant lid to the filter box
- 14. Using the gasket provided tighten the MAF to the volant duct
- 15. Re attach the battery cables
